1. Karnataka govt launches "Gram One programme" in 12 districts



- Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai launched Gram One programme in 3026 Gram Panchayats spread over 12 districts on 26 January 2022.
- The scheme is aimed at taking government services to the doors of people at the grass-root level.
- Gram One kiosks will provide Aadhar Card, Ration card, Caste certificates and other services related to the department of Agriculture, Horticulture, Revenue, Women and Child Welfare and Social Welfare.
- A separate cell is set up with equipment and data entry operators in the offices of tahsildars to receive the applications.
- The e-governance department will be monitoring and reviewing the programme. This will prevent people in villages from going to Taluk offices and reduce corruption.
- All the applications will be received through the kiosks and fed into the Government portal and processed online.
- Modern technology will play a key role in taking the villages from "Gram Swaraj to Gram Suraj", a dream of Atal Bihari Vajpayee.



- During the experimental stage of Gram One programme, about six lakh petitions were received and services provided without a hitch in four districts.

The 28-pillar supported hall is first of its kind in the State with grand entry, porch, covered double ramps with transparent full roof view.



## 3. Ukraine-Russia crisis: US rejects Russia's demand to bar Ukraine from NATO

- The US has rejected Russia's demand to bar Ukraine from NATO, amid warnings Russia might invade its neighbour.
- According to Secretary of State Antony Blinken, was giving Russia a formal response to its demands to resolve the Ukraine crisis.
- Mr Blinken was offering Russia "a serious diplomatic path forward and it should accept this.
- According to the Russian minister, his country would study Mr Blinken's response, delivered in coordination with NATO.
- Russia had issued a written list of its concerns about the expansion of the NATO military alliance and related security issues.
- Among them was a demand for NATO to rule out the possibility of Ukraine and others ever joining the alliance.

1. Odisha Open 2022 to kick off at Jawaharlal Nehru Indoor Stadium in Cuttack





### 6. City Union Bank launches fitness watch debit card in tie-up with GOQii

- According to bank, Payments made using this Debit Card in a Fitness
  Watch are safe and secure.
  - For each transaction done using the watch, SMS will be sent to the registered mobile number.
  - Customers can raise a request for the Fitness Watch Debit Card through Net banking/ Mobile banking.
  - Usage of wristwatches can be managed by customers on their own through CUB All in One Mobile App.

# 7. Apple retained the title as world's valuable brand in Brand Finance 2022

- Apple has retained its position as the most valuable brand in 2022 as well, according to the **Brand Finance 2022 Global 500 report.** The brand valuation of Apple was recorded at \$355.1 billion in 2022, which is an increase of 35% from last year. This is the highest brand value ever recorded in the Brand Finance Global 500 ranking history.
- The Indian conglomerate **Tata Group** has emerged as the most valuable brand from India and also in South Asia. It is the only brand from the country in the top 100. The Global Rank of Tata Group 78. The brand value of Tata Group is **US\$23.9 billion.**
- **TikTok (18th)** has been named the world's fastest-growing brand in the list. Its brand value increased from US\$18.7 billion in 2021 to US\$59.0 billion in 2022.
- Tech remained the most valuable industry in the list in terms of sector.
   This was followed by Retail, Banking, Media and Telecoms in top 5 respectively.
